27 John St. South (Former Morgan Brothers Whip Factory)

27 John Street South was constructed in 1978 on the site of two 19th-century four-storey brick buildings, located at 27 and 29 John Street South. 27 and 29 John Street South were the site of Morgan Brothers' whip factory in the late-19th century and were demolished by 1964. A one-storey concrete-block commercial building was constructed in 1978.



Pictured here is the building at 27 John St. South before it was demolished and turned into a one store building, currently Saigon House restaurant. To the left in the background the Royal Connaught is visible and the Royal Court building is directly next to the building with Beneficial Loans and Vogue Hair Styling on the ground floor.
