## 92 Jackson St. East.

94 Jackson Street East was constructed as a semi-detached dwelling in the late 19th century, consisting of 92 and 94 Jackson Street East. In 1870 the city directory listed 92-94 Jackson St. E. (Maiden Lane at the time) as William Lyons boarding house.

The building was modified into a single-detached restaurant in the mid-20th century. The building has a hip roof with projecting eaves, a tall single-stack brick chimney side left and a gabled parapet (covered with flashing), with corbelled brick ends, separating the former units. The building is clad with stucco and the foundation is clad with a modern stone finish.
